

Information about the format of the project proposal

Your Project proposal should outline a clear scientific idea and should include the following:

- Title and topic reference number from <https://www.edinburgh-robotics.org/projects-list>
- Title and project number 500000 if proposing your own topic
- Describe why your idea is worth pursuing
- Outline how it has been approached previously
- Describe what worked in that approach
- Detail how you would approach your research topic
- Demonstrate how this is different/better than any previous approach

Please remember to include the reference details of a further three advertised projects in which you might be interested.

Please note that we do not have any particular requirements with regard to font or style, but we would recommend that you use the above bullet points to help structure your proposal.

We also do not stipulate an expected word count, but we would suggest 2 to 3 A4 pages (including references) of single spaced type should allow most candidates to submit a quality proposal.
